Payment model: Antepartum or postpartum doula visit: \$100; Synchronous audio/video antepartum or postpartum doula visit: \$100

No-PHI reminder: do not add client names, Medicaid IDs, dates of birth, service dates, claim numbers, or visit notes to public tools or shared PDFs.

Service	Code	Modifier	Rate / unit
Antepartum or postpartum doula visit	T1033	-	\$100 flat
Synchronous audio/video antepartum or postpartum doula visit	T1033	95	\$100 flat
In-person attendance at labor and delivery	T1033	HD	\$800 flat

Documentation checklist

- Retain a handwritten or electronic recommendation, referral, or order from a licensed and enrolled CMAP/HUSKY Health practitioner.
- Document the member's name, address, birth date, Medicaid ID, pertinent diagnostic information, signed visit notes, services provided, service dates, location, and referral documentation.
- Track four total antepartum/postpartum visits before prior authorization; additional medically necessary visits require PA before services are rendered.
- For telemedicine visits, document that the member requested telemedicine, both parties agreed, the service used synchronized audio/video, and no more than half of total visits are telemedicine.
- Do not bill labor and delivery attendance by telemedicine; CT reimburses that line only for in-person attendance.

Common denial check	Next action
Licensed-practitioner referral missing	Retain the referral or order before submitting the claim.
More than four visits need prior authorization	Confirm the visit count and obtain PA through CHNCT before services beyond four; DoulaPaid blocks that path until PA fields are added.
Telemedicine limit exceeded	Use in-person service or correct the visit count before billing.
