

Kansas Medicaid doula billing guide



Kansas Medicaid (KanCare) doula services

Sources checked: 2026-07-11. **Effective:** 2024-07-01.

Payment model: Prenatal doula visits, per 15 minutes: \$15; Attendance at labor and delivery: \$500

Protect client information: Keep client names, Medicaid IDs, birth dates, service dates, claim numbers, visit notes, and signed records in private systems.

Service	Code	Modifier	Rate / unit
Prenatal doula visits, per 15 minutes	T1032	-	\$15 / 15 minutes
Attendance at labor and delivery	T1033	-	\$500 / service
Postpartum doula visits, per 15 minutes	T1032	TS	\$15 / 15 minutes

Documentation checklist

- KanCare covers doula services for dates of service on and after July 1, 2024, from confirmed conception through one year postpartum.
- Services must be recommended by a licensed practitioner before the doula service is rendered.
- Use diagnosis Z33.1 for prenatal T1032 and T1033 labor/delivery, and diagnosis Z39.2 with modifier TS for postpartum T1032.
- Prenatal T1032 is limited to 28 15-minute units; postpartum T1032 TS is limited to 25 15-minute units.
- T1033 is limited to once per 280 days unless documentation supports a separate pregnancy.

Common denial check	Next action
Missing licensed-practitioner recommendation	Obtain and retain the recommendation before claim entry.
Unit limit exceeded	Recount units and split prenatal/postpartum services before payer entry.
Labor and delivery frequency limit	Check prior delivery claims and pregnancy documentation.
