New York Medicaid doula services

Sources checked: 2026-06-22. **Effective:** 2024-03-01.

Payment model: New York City perinatal support visit, minimum 30 minutes: \$93.75; Rest of State perinatal support visit, minimum 30 minutes: \$84.37

No-PHI reminder: do not add client names, Medicaid IDs, dates of birth, service dates, claim numbers, or visit notes to public tools or shared PDFs.

New York City perinatal support visit, minimum 30 minutes	T1032	-	\$93.75 flat
Rest of State perinatal support visit, minimum 30 minutes	T1032	-	\$84.37 flat
New York City in-person labor and delivery support	T1033	-	\$750 flat
Rest of State in-person labor and delivery support	T1033	-	\$675 flat

Documentation checklist

- For dates of service on or after 2025-04-01, bill the member's Medicaid Managed Care plan directly when the member is in MMC; use FFS/eMedNY only when the member is in FFS.
- For T1032 perinatal visits, document at least 30 minutes of prenatal or postpartum doula support and use Z32.2 or Z32.3 as appropriate.
- For T1033 labor and delivery, document in-person support during labor and birth, one unit, and use Z32.2.
- Track no more than eight perinatal visits and one labor/delivery encounter per pregnancy/postpartum benefit period.
- Keep the eMedNY provider NPI, member CIN, service date, procedure code, diagnosis code, and one billed unit ready for claim entry.

Common denial check	Next action
Missing New York Medicaid CIN	Verify eligibility and add the CIN from the member card before payer entry.
NYC or Rest of State rate not chosen	Choose New York City or Rest of New York State on the client profile before pricing the service.
Diagnosis code does not match NY guidance	Confirm the visit type and update the diagnosis code before billing.
