

Oregon Medicaid doula billing guide



Oregon Health Plan birth doula services

Sources checked: 2026-06-17. **Effective:** 2025-01-01.

Payment model: \$1,505 global package; includes 2 prenatal and 2 postpartum visits.

Protect client information: Keep client names, Medicaid IDs, birth dates, service dates, claim numbers, visit notes, and signed records in private systems.

Service	Code	Modifier	Rate / unit
Global doula package	Package	-	\$1,505 / service
Global doula benefit with support at delivery	T1033	HD	\$1,505
Support visit	T1033	-	\$215
Doula services day of delivery only	T1033	22	\$645

Documentation checklist

- Track whether the global package is complete before billing the global line.
- Use itemized support or delivery-only lines only when an extenuating circumstance prevents the global package; never combine global and itemized billing for the same pregnancy.
- For every encounter, include service dates, education or services provided, needs beyond routine care, and referrals made.
- For labor and delivery, include the doula's name and length of time services were provided during labor and delivery.
- Bill Oregon FFS on a professional claim; CCO members may have plan-specific billing instructions.

Common denial check	Next action
Global package not complete	Confirm an extenuating circumstance before using an itemized line; otherwise complete the global package requirements.
Global package billed more than once	Check prior claims before creating a new global packet.
CCO or FFS unclear	Confirm whether the client is Open Card or CCO before submission, then send the claim to the correct place.
