Utah Medicaid doula services

Sources checked: 2026-06-20. **Effective:** 2026-04-01.

Payment model: Pregnancy and postpartum doula services, per 15 minutes: \$11.59; Labor support doula services, per diem: \$834.28

Protect client information: Keep client names, Medicaid IDs, birth dates, service dates, claim numbers, visit notes, and signed records in private systems.

Service	Code	Modifier	Rate / unit
Pregnancy and postpartum doula services, per 15 minutes	T1032	-	\$11.59 / 15 minutes
Labor support doula services, per diem	T1033	-	\$834.28 / service

Documentation checklist

- Utah's Medicaid doula benefit is effective for dates of service on and after April 1, 2026 (CMS-approved SPA).
- Complete the Utah Medicaid Doula Provider Attestation and enroll in PRISM under the new doula provider type with an individual NPI.
- Use PRISM PAC 180 Doula rows: T1032 is paid at \$11.59 per 15-minute unit and T1033 is paid at \$834.28 per diem.
- T1032 pregnancy/postpartum services are limited to 32 units per year and T1033 labor support is limited to one unit per year.
- PRISM release notes opened T1032 and T1033 for doula services effective April 1, 2026; confirm member plan routing before billing managed-care claims.

Common denial check	Next action
PAC 180 enrollment missing	Confirm PRISM enrollment, attestation, NPI, and provider type before claim entry.
T1032 unit limit exceeded	Recount annual T1032 units before billing or route to payer review.
T1033 frequency limit reached	Check prior labor support billing for the member before payer entry.
